We also provide a light snack, and build in plenty of social time so you can connect with your classmates.

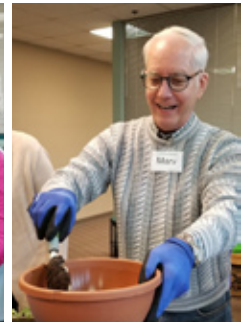
**Flexible commitment:** Each class stands alone, so you can attend however many you choose.
